Sponsored by CareOne partnering with The National Arts Program®, the exhibit is judged by professional artists and visual art professionals in Amateur, Intermediate, Advanced/Professional and Youth classifications, and it is free to all eligible participants. ## ELIGIBILITY

### Participants must be a:

- CareOne Resident of (Cupola or Ridgewood Ave.) or an immediate family member/friend
- Employee of CareOne (Cupola or Ridgewood Ave.) or an immediate family member/friend
- Employee of CareOne – North Jersey Region Activities Department (Advanced/Professional category only)
- Professional or Advanced Artists from our Bergen County Service area (live, work or study)

All entries submitted must be the original work of the applicant. Not accepted: kits, paint-by-number pieces, photocopies or photographs of artwork, magazine or book illustrations, random snapshots. CareOne reserves the right to disqualify entries they consider to be unacceptable or inappropriate for a public exhibit.

## MEDIUM CATEGORIES

- Painting (oils, acrylics)
- Works on Paper (watercolor, pencil, ink, charcoal, pastel, marker, crayon, digital)
- Photography (black and white; color)
- Sculpture (space limited/register early)
- Mixed Media (a work of visual art that combines more than one medium)

## CLASSIFICATIONS

Artwork will be judged in the classification of the artist's selection; however, in some cases, the exhibition judges will make the final determination.

### ADULT

Amateur – a person with little or no experience

Intermediate – a person with some experience, beginning art students, etc.

Advanced/Professional – a person with serious art training, or employed in an art related job

### YOUTH/TEEN

Youth – 12 years and under

Teen – 13-18 years old

## PRIZES & AWARDS

### Prizes will be awarded by classification:

**Adult** (Amateur, Intermediate, Advanced/Professional)

- 3 – First Place Awards of \$350
- 3 – Second Place Awards of \$250
- 3 – Third Place Awards of \$150
- Best of Show – \$400

**Youth/Teen** (Youth 12 & under; Teen 13-18)

- 2 – First Place Awards of \$150
- 2 – Second Place Awards of \$100
- 2 – Third Place Awards of \$50

- Honorable Mention Ribbons will be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
- Awards are limited to one cash award per artist per classification.
- Each artist receives a Certificate of Participation from CareOne and The National Arts Program®.

## PREPARING ENTRIES

- Submit only entries that fit into the listed medium categories.
- All artwork will need an identification label placed on the back.
- All 2-dimensional entries should be matted, framed and/or ready to hang with wire securely on the back.
- All work must measure no more than 36" in any direction or weigh more than 20 pounds unless otherwise stipulated.
- Artwork that does not meet size limitations or specifications will be disqualified before judging.
