In many cases, hospital stays are short and generally last an expected amount of time. Other times, however, things may not go exactly as planned and a longer stay in an acute care environment is needed. LTACHs (Long Term Acute Care Hospitals) are specialized hospitals that provide a level of care, one step below that of an Intensive Care Unit. Patients admitted to a LTACH require that longer length of stay to resolve the acute challenges they are facing.

THE VALUE OF LOCATION

Where a LTACH is located can make all the difference in the world. This is not only from a convenience of travel standpoint, but where the actual unit is located. When it is determined that a LTACH is the appropriate level of care, choosing the right LTACH for the patient's specific needs becomes front and center. **This begins by choosing a LTACH that is physically within another hospital.** Patients that require this level of care often need the immediate services of lab, x-ray, operating rooms, intensive care units and other services that are only found in an existing acute care hospital. Being cared for in a LTACH that is within a hospital can avoid unneeded ambulance trips, provide access to all the services needed to maximize the patient's outcome and to help you feel confident and secure in the safety of a trusted hospital or medical center.



WHY LTACH?

Hospitals and Regional Medical Centers are designed for patients that generally have a short term length of stay. LTACH's however, are specially designed for patients that require a longer length of stay. Our nurses, respiratory therapists, physicians and staff understand from the moment a patient arrives that their length of stay may average approximately 25 days. The multidisciplinary care plans created for these patients are then designed to maximize the clinical outcome of the patient over a longer length of time.

Weaning a patient from a ventilator isn't just about the lungs; it's about the entire mind and body. This weaning process requires a skillful combination of proven protocols, reliable and state of the art technology, and teamwork between respiratory therapists and physicians. Our collaborative multi-disciplinary approach combines the efforts of nursing, respiratory, nutrition, and rehab therapies to produce the highest probability of weaning from the ventilator. The well respected, board certified pulmonologists that are credentialed at the CareOne LTAC Hospitals work hand in hand with our experienced respiratory therapists daily to deliver the best ventilator weaning outcomes in the tri state area. **Our end goal is simple: To restore full breathing function to the patient whenever possible.**

Highly trained wound care nurses aren't a luxury at the CareOne LTAC Hospitals; they are an integral part of our care. In fact, with over 10 certified wound care RNs, our ability to heal a wide variety of serious and non-healing wounds rivals the best in the country. The plan of care for wound care patients involves a carefully monitored balance of specialized nursing, dietary and rehabilitative therapies, typically combined with treatment of various secondary issues— including generalized weakness, infection and nutritional complications. In collaboration with the patient's physician and/or surgeon, the wound care team at LTAC works to develop a plan of care specific to each patient's unique situation. Additionally, our state of the art technology provides us with all the tools needed to take wound care to the next level. From our top of the line hospital beds, to our Negative Pressure Wound Therapy systems, wound care is always front and center. **We strive to have the highest possible percentage of a patient's wounds healed or healing at discharge.**
